The 68th Annual Santa Cruz Christmas Bird Count Final Report

The 68th Santa Cruz CBC was held on Saturday, December 21, 2024. Intermittent, light rain fell throughout most of count day, which unfortunately excluded the possibility of any offshore pelagic



effort, but all other teams forged ahead and were able to make the most of the day. While landbirding seemed slow at times due to the rain, the sea watch effort turned out to be particularly productive.

In a surprise result considering the weather, the species total of 184 was the highest recorded on this count since

2003! This year's species count was also quite high

compared to the recent (10-year) average of 167 species; the count had not cracked the 180 species threshold in nearly 20 years. The total birds (47,124) and birds per hour (169) this year were both well-above the recent averages of 37,518 birds and 140 birds per hour, providing reason for cautious optimism that the long-term decline in species and numbers on this count may reverse. Participation in the count remains high; the 125 birders who participated this year was the second-most ever! The 278 field hours logged by this large contingent



matched the recent average, which was an impressive mark considering this year's inclement weather.

Leading a long list of rarities on count day was a **White Wagtail** (2nd count record, 6th county record) found by Emma Arul and group at Wilder Beach. Additional species of significance for the count included the following: **Lark Bunting** and **Black-footed Albatross** (1st count records); **Clay-**

colored Sparrow and Magnolia Warbler (2nd count records), and Barrow's Goldeneye and Pacific Golden-Plovers (3rd count records). A Short-eared Owl was the first seen on the count

since 1999, and a flock of **Dunlins** were the first since 2003.

Numbers of seabirds were generally high, likely because of the stormy weather and enhanced sea watching effort. A record 5,959 Brandt's Cormorants and 1,907 Brown Pelicans were counted, and 3,070 Common Murres were well-above the recent average of 530. All of the loon species posted good numbers on count day as well. A total of 377 Wild Turkeys was a record count, and 290 Canada Geese was the second-highest total ever; the populations of both these species continue to increase throughout the county.

The eight
White-breasted
Nuthatches tallied on

count day was the highest since 1986.

Winter irruptive species were generally scarce or in average numbers. The Golden-crowned Kinglet was the only irruptive with decent numbers; a total of 21 was higher than in recent years. Otherwise, American Robin and Pine Siskin numbers were low, and shockingly, only 9 (!) American Goldfinches were found—a paltry total compared to the recent average of 157 and the lowest total since 1958.



Otherwise, numbers of many common birds such as Chestnut-backed Chickadee, Dark-eyed Junco, Golden-crowned and White-crowned Sparrow, and Song Sparrow were close to their recent averages. This indicates that the especially high total number of birds recorded on this year's count was due to higher numbers of seabirds.

A sincere thanks to all the participants for their efforts to further document the patterns and trends of



our winter bird populations. I would also like to thank especially the section leaders for all the additional responsibilities they accept that ultimately makes the count run smoothly. Thanks also to the Santa Cruz Bird Club, and specifically Ann Chandler and Larry Corridon, for organizing the countdown dinner, and to my cocompilers, Nick Levendosky and Phil Brown, for making the section assignments and handling logistics leading up to count day.
